VOLUNTEER

HOST A FOOD DRIVE

COMMUNITY CAFÉS

The downtown Fort Myers café location is open to serve freshly prepared lunch to anyone in the community. The Fort Myers Beach café location is open for breakfast.

COMMUNITY MARKET

With a choice-centered model, clients can shop in our food pantry just like they would in a grocery store. Fresh produce and healthy food items are staples available in the market.

MOBILE FOOD PANTRIES

An extension of the Community Market, the Mobile Pantry Program brings groceries to all corners of Lee County to provide easier food access for neighbors in need.

MEALS ON WHEELS

Hot, fresh meals are prepared daily and delivered to the homebound elderly, ill, or disabled who are unable to shop or prepare their own food.

GROWING HEALTHY KIDS PROGRAMS

The Food Literacy in Preschool (FLIP) program partners with low-income schools to provide a curriculum built around the introduction of fresh produce in a fun and engaging way, encouraging the next generation to form healthy food habits.

SOCIAL SERVICES

Social Workers provide homeless services, access to resources, and education opportunities as well as a family stability program focused on homeless prevention to clients in need to help them become self-sufficient and rebuild their lives with dignity.
